
Tradition of Collaborations

- Currently ca. 20 networks







- Intermediaries are in a crucial role
- Members are Science Parks, Regional Development Agencies, Universities and Universities of Applied Sciences, Flagship Projects, Companies, Knowledge Clusters...
- Focus on competitiveness, innovations, European cooperation



S3 priorities of Southwest Finland

Blue economy and renewing industry

- Especially ship building, autonomous vessels, fuel systems
 - Almost 30 % of Finnish maritime industry jobs and Finnish maritime industry revenue
- Focus on RDI, international networks, clean and resource efficient solutions
 - European Maritime Hotspots project
 - Regional Expert Group



S3 priorities of Southwest Finland

Innovative food chains

- "Finland's granary"
 - Forerunner in sustainability in food production
 - Wheat, plant proteins, vegetables
 - Most of eggs in Finland, 1/4 of pork
- Focus on blue (aqua culture, fisheries) and green bioeconomy, multidiciplinary co-creation, digital solutions
 - Several regional working groups
 - Member of European Regions for Innovation in Agriculture, Food and Forestry



S3 priorities of Southwest Finland

Life Science and Health Technology

- Finland's strongest life science hub
 - 95 % of pharmaceuticals developed in Finland, over 75 % of Finnish pharmaceuticals exports, over 100 companies
 - National pharmaceuticals development centre established in Turku
- Focus on pharmaceuticals and diagnostics, bioimaging, technology and data
 - Euro Biolmaging ERIC Headquarters
 - Regional working group
