Main problem


Very few existing swimming areas are available to all, which restricts access to certain target groups, especially wheelchair users, to explore nature and travel on waterways. Local and regional districts are also very interested in tackling this challenge by the large number of applications received for participation in the cross-border projects

The main objective of the project is to improve the existing infrastructure for people with mobility impairments, as well as senior citizens and families with small childrens

Plan is to build a boardwalk in Lielezers for people with mobility impairments, to create a place where it's easier to board in boat, or getting into a kayak, and a ramp for safe entry into the water for people with mobility impairments.
