

VIDZEME REGION IN A NUTSHELL

- One of 5 planning regions in Latvia (NUTS 3); 11 municipalities
- Largest region in Latvia 1/3 (19809 km2 or 31 %) of the entire territory of Latvia;
- ~273 835 inhabitants* (14,6 % of the whole country)
- Lowest density 14* people/km2 (average in Latvia – 30*)
- 56 % of the territory covered by forests
- Latvia's largest and oldest national park, Gauja National Park
- Strong tradition of field- and forest-driven economy
- The first Bioregion Latvia







Sustainable tourism and recreation is one of the areas of smart specialization set in **Development Strategy of** Vidzeme Planning Region for 2015-2030. The planned activities and specific results of the project will contribute to the implementation of the objective of Development Program of Vidzeme Planning Region for 2022-2027: "To preserve and wisely manage natural ecosystems and resources" Priority T2. "Natural and cultural heritage" specifically "To promote the sustainable use of cultural and natural heritage in tourism" and "Improve accessibility to cultural objects, nature places and promote improvements in public outdoor space infrastructure".

RIVERWAYS II (2024-2027)

Vidzeme is rich in natural water resources:

- The most popular rivers for boating in Vidzeme are Gauja, Brasla, Salaca, Aiviekste, Ogre, Amata and Pededze.
- The biggest and most visited lakes in Vidzeme are Lubāns, Burtnieks, Alūksnes Lake, Alauksts, Inesis, and Ungurs.

There are many other smaller but not less attractive rivers and lakes in our region.
