# KULDĪGA MUNICIPALITY

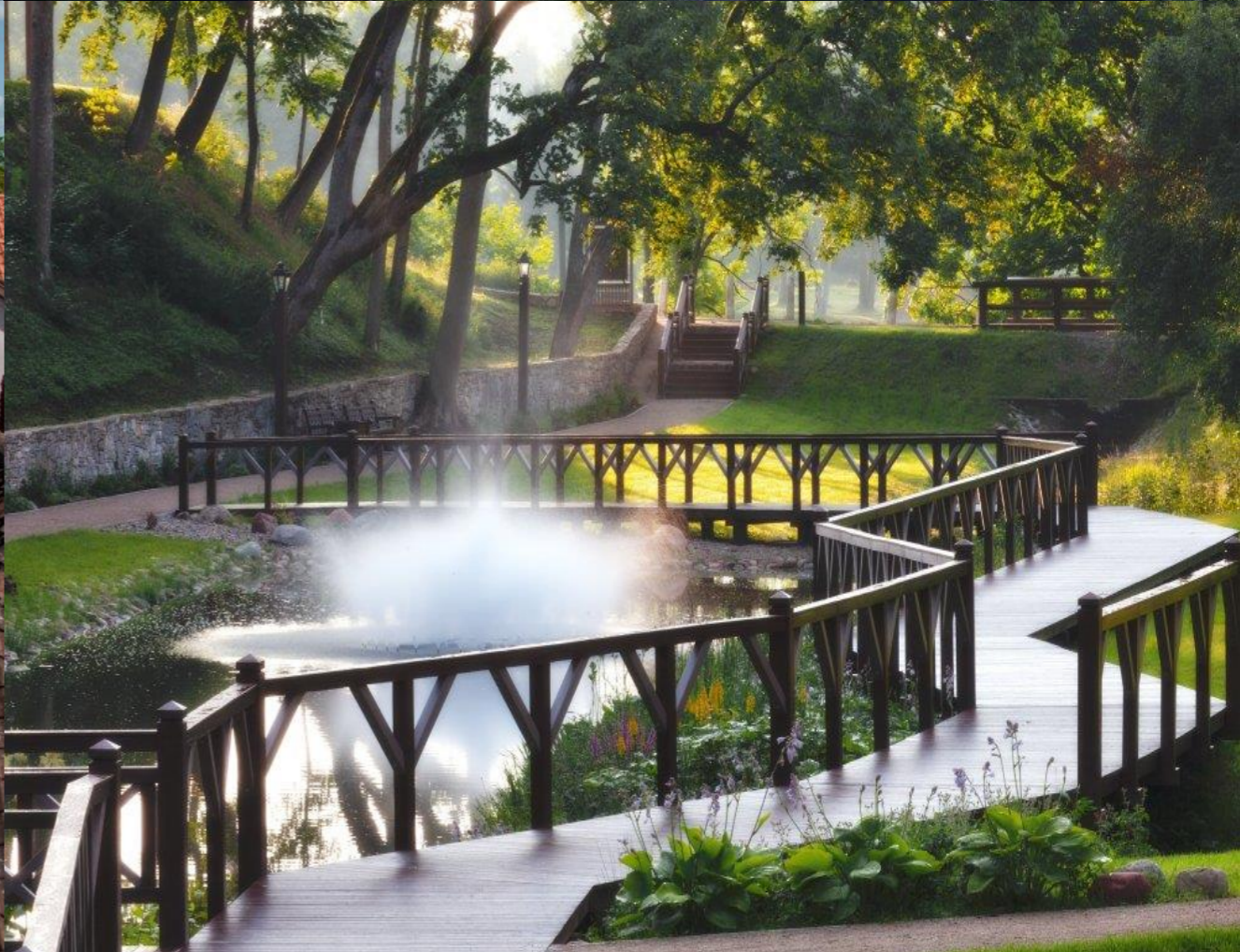

Kuldīga Municipality (PP8) will serve as a pilot investment site with 1 site on the bank of Venta River in Skrunda.

**The primary aim** - to improve the existing nature/culture heritage site near the Skrunda hillfort and access a waterroute section along the Venta River in Skrunda.

PP8 will create and test innovative solutions for constructing 2 piers. One of them will be a multifunctional pier suitable for boating, kayaking, canoeing, fishing, swimming, environmental education and recreation. Improvement of access to adjacent resting areas is also planned.

**Result:** an accessible 16 km waterroute connecting the two piers. (D.1.1.3., Period 4)

**Budget:** 54 200,00 EUR

PP8 will participate in other relevant joint project activities, such as the cross-border hackathon in Vidzeme, experience exchange visit & training for watertourism operators in Kurzeme region and the general Project Coordination meetings.
