Entrance into the building without obstacles, e.g. alternative path/route or lift, ramp (height-length proportion not more than 1:12 (8%), width 1,20m, railing at two heights 70cm and 90cm)

Description

Accessible city walking route



The route shows the key touristic attractions in the centre of Ventspils and allows to get to know the central part of the city. It's gonna be a very pleasant 4km walk, accessible for all. The route is drawn with a key theme of COWS[©] And why cows? Yes, why there are so many cow statues in Ventspils? Starting with 2002, few projects named "Cow parades" have been held in the city. And now about 30 cow sculptures of different size, color and look, created by Latvian and foreign artists, can be found in the streets, squares and park of Ventspils. So go ahead and find some!
